We're looking forward to a "Summer of Wonder" with your family! To ensure success for all, it is our desire for you to be well informed with our daily operating procedures. Please read carefully the following information, and don't hesitate to inquire if you have any concerns or questions. The **PHONE #** for camp is 386-672-2081 located in the school office.

NEW this summer: All weekly **PAYMENTS** must be paid at the office by the Friday prior to your child attending. This includes fees for those using the camp on a per day basis and extended care. Fees for premium field trips are to be paid on or before the morning of the field trip. You may text your payment to 386-246-7870 (keyword: SummerCamp). Checks can be made out to Calvary Christian Academy, or we accept debit/credit cards. Returned checks will result in a \$35 returned check fee and require an alternate payment method for the remainder of the summer. (*Text payments are easy and the preferred method for camp fees and tuition.) Campers will not be permitted to stay if payments are not made before 8:00 AM on Monday of that week's camp.

Summer camp **HOURS** are 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM. You may use the extended hours from 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM for an added fee. Children must be picked up by 6:00 to avoid a late charge of \$1 per minute paid on the day of pick up to the extended care personnel.

Procedures for **ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL** are as follows: parents must **sign in & sign out** ALL campers upon arrival & dismissal in the designated area. Children are never to be unattended outside of the camp areas. Unless a call from you has been made to our office prior to dismissal, your child will *never* be released to anyone other than those on the emergency pick up list. Changes to that list can only be made in writing and signed by the individual who signed the registration form. CCA reserves the right to ask for an ID of anyone picking up a child. Please advise all who might offer to pick up your child.

On any **FIELD TRIP** day, departure times are definite. Your child needs to arrive 30 minutes prior to departure for sign in and bus loading. Please be aware that children arriving later than the 30 minute mark jeopardizes their ability to attend. Return times are approximate, and should changes occur, we'll do our best to provide a note on the sign in paper as well as using the email address you provided.

Summer camp offers a **FOOD** program which includes breakfast, lunch, and an afternoon snack. OR, you may choose to pack your child's lunch and a snack for each day. Refrigeration for packed lunches is not available, and microwave use is limited. All extras such as plastic utensils, napkins, bowls, etc. should be a part of packed lunches. What God provided for us is considered a healthy snack; which is a must! The application for the food program (which secures their meals each day) must be completed and submitted prior to the start of camp. Guidelines for the food program will be followed. Please note: unless a premium field trip day requires a packed lunch, you must choose one or the other for the duration of camp – *lunch program* **OR** *packed lunch*. The two may not be combined. Any **FOOD ALLERGIES** must be noted on the registration form.

If your child is taking a prescription or over-the-counter **MEDICATION**, it must be turned in to the summer camp staff at the start of the day needed and be in its original container along with specific instructions. Medication forms must be completed and filed in the office prior to the start of administering.

Please be sure to label all **PERSONAL BELONGINGS** with the camper's name. We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen personal items. We have a lost and found closet that you may check should something be missing. We also ask that you monitor what your child brings with them each day. We are a part of a Christian school however items still go missing even as much as we try our best to prevent that from happening.

We understand that summer is a time of a more relaxed atmosphere, but a **DISCIPLINE POLICY** still needs to be in place regardless the time of year. Behavior problems will be dealt with by one or more of the following methods based on the seriousness of the offense: verbal warning, time out, time out with writing, minor work detail (e.g. straightening chairs, sweeping, cleaning tables, etc.) loss of time from activities or field trips, phone call to parents, meeting with parents, or termination from the program.

At times, we create brochures and other advertisements that are published for our CCA programs. These may include **USE OF PHOTOS** of children enrolled in our summer program. If you do not want for your child to be included, please give a signed written request to the office before June 4, 2018.

During summer camp, we expect our campers to **DRESS** in appropriate & modest summer clothing for comfort in warmer months. Campers may not arrive in clothing advertising alcohol or tobacco, or bathing suits. Tee shirts with sayings should reflect Christian behaviors.
